Rules and Undertakings

1. Exhibitors must have Public Liability Insurance.
2. The recording of movements to the show is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
3. Cattle passports **MUST** be given to Cattle Secretary on arrival and will be returned after the Grand Parade.
4. Bulls must be handled in accordance with HSE Guidance – Notes GS36 “safe custody of bulls at agricultural shows” e.g.-
All bulls to have two handlers
All bulls over the age of 10 months to be ringed or led by bulldogs.
5. Straw, Electricity Points, Water and Milking Facilities will be provided.
6. Cattle may arrive the day before after midday.
7. Cattle to be on the showground by **9.00am** on day of show.
8. Cattle to remain on the showground until **after the Grand Parade**.
9. Cattle must be tethered at the Societies standing.
10. The Society reserves the right to **Create** or **Amalgamate** classes depending on entries.
11. Any Breed Class with six or more entries will have an additional prize of **4th - £10** awarded.
12. Champions, Reserve Champions and 1st Prize Winners in all Cattle Sections **will be required** to take part in the Grand Parade where Trophies will be presented. All Prize Winners are invited to take part if they wish.
13. Closing date for entries: **31st July 2010**.

Prize Money: 1st - £30; 2nd - £20; 3rd - £15

Commercial Beef

Judge:

1. The cross must be given on the entry form (name of breed sired first). If a Pure Bred animal is entered in this section, it must not be entered in any other classes i.e. its respective breed section.
2. An animal may not be entered in more than one class, with the exception of the Pairs class open to all cattle irrespective of breed.
3. All animals must be double tagged. These will be checked at the show against the entry form.
4. Bullocks must be castrated to the satisfaction of the stewards.
5. Heifers must be guaranteed free of calf.
6. If the conditions of entry are not upheld, the prize-money will be forfeited.
7. In the event of any dispute the decision of the Cattle Secretary shall be final.

Cm1 Bullock

British Limousin or British Limousin cross-sired. Any weight.

Cm2 Bullock

British Blue or British Blue cross-sired. Any weight.

Cm3 Bullock

Any other continental type breed or breed cross-sired. Any weight.

Cm4 Bullock

Any native type breed or breed cross-sired. Any weight.

Cm5 Heifer

British Limousin or British Limousin cross sired beef heifer. Any weight.

Cm6 Heifer

British Blue or British Blue cross sired beef heifer. Any weight.

Cm7 Heifer

Any other continental type breed or breed cross-sired beef. Any weight.

Cm8 Heifer

Any native type breed or breed cross-sired. Any weight.

Commercial Championship: Champion - £150 plus The Kenneth Holmes Trophy; Reserve - £75. Open to all first placed exhibits in classes Cm1 to Cm8 and then once the Champion has been determined, the second placed exhibit from the champions' class may enter the ring, to determine Reserve Champion.

Champion - £100; Reserve - £75. Open to Continental Beef Breed Champions (Not Commercial Beef or Baby Beef), and then once the Champion has been determined, the Reserve of the champions breed may enter the ring to determine Reserve of the interbreed.

Interbreed Native Pure Bred Beef Championship: Judge:

Champion - £100; Reserve - £75. Open to Native Beef Breed Champions (Not Commercial Beef or Baby Beef), and then once the Champion has been determined, the Reserve of the champions breed may enter the ring to determine Reserve of the interbreed.

To first calving, having calved her first calf at under 3 years of age.

DC4 Cow, in calf or in milk

Having calved at least twice.

DC5 Young Calf

Born in 2010.

Breed Championship: Champion - £50; Reserve - £25. Open to all first placed exhibits in classes DC1 to DC5 and then once the Champion has been determined, the second placed exhibit from the Champions' class may enter the ring, to determine Reserve Champion.

Dairy Shorthorn

Under 18 months of age on show day.

Not more than 3 years of age on show day, and due to calve at not more than 3 years and one month.

DC8 Heifer, in milk

To first calving, having calved her first calf at under 3 years of age.

DC9 Cow, in calf or in milk

Having calved at least twice.

DC10 Young Calf

Born in 2010.

Breed Championship: Champion - £50; Reserve - £25. Open to all first placed exhibits in classes DC6 to DC10 and then once the Champion has been determined, the second placed exhibit from the Champions' class may enter the ring, to determine Reserve Champion.

Any Other Dairy Breed

DC11 Maiden Heifer

Under 18 months of age on show day.

DC12 Heifer, in calf with first calf

Not more than 3 years of age on show day, and due to calve at not more than 3 years and one month.

DC13 Heifer, in milk

To first calving, having calved her first calf at under 3 years of age.

DC14 Cow, in calf or in milk

Having calved at least twice.

DC15 Young Calf

Born in 2010.

Breed Championship: Champion - £50; Reserve - £25. Open to all first placed exhibits in classes DC11 to DC15 and then once the Champion has been determined, the second placed exhibit from the Champions' class may enter the ring, to determine Reserve Champion.

Interbreed Dairy Championship:

Judge:

Champion - £150 plus The Shaw Edge Trophy; Reserve - £75. Open to Dairy Breed Champions and then once the Interbreed Champion has been determined, the Reserve of the Champions' breed may enter the ring to determine Reserve of the Dairy Interbreed.

Young Handlers

Prize Money: 1st - £15; 2nd - £10; 3rd - £5

Owners of the cattle must ensure the young person is capable of controlling the animal involved. The animal size must be in relation to the size of the handler and must be used to being handled. Strictly No Bulls.

An experienced adult must be near by (within the ring) during the event. The judge or steward has the authority to send from the ring any exhibitor not having sufficient control of their animal.
