All Sheep & Lambs must be tagged with UK flock number & individually identified and they must be equipped with a Movement License (AML1)

RULES in addition to the General Rules:

1. No entry will be accepted unless it is:
 - A) On an official form
 - B) accompanied by the correct fee
2. The judge's decision will be final.
3. Sheep will be the owner's responsibility and the committee cannot be held responsible for loss, damage or injury to sheep, property or vehicles.
4. There must be competition in all classes and we reserve the right to alter classes and restrict the prize money in the event of insufficient entries.
5. Sheep must be penned by 9.45 a.m. and must be kept on the show ground until 4.30 p.m.
6. Please state on entry form if sheep are accredited.
7. It is recommended that all sheep brought to the show ground be protected from sheep scab either by dipping with an approved dip, or by treatment by another approved method.
8. The committee reserve the right to refuse entry of any sheep showing indications of any contagious disease.
9. Sheep in fat lamb and Young Handler Classes cannot be shown in any other class.
10. Children in Young Handler classes cannot show in any other classes.
