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FOR EXHIBITORS

- 1.** ALL ENTRY FORMS, ACCOMPANIED BY THE ENTRY FEE SHOULD BE RECEIVED BY THE SECRETARY NO LATER THAN FRIDAY 13TH AUGUST 2010
- 2.** CLASS TICKETS WILL BE SUPPLIED; EXHIBITORS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE PLACING OF THEM BY THEIR EXHIBIT.
- 3.** ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE STAGED BY 8.30.AM ON SATURDAY 14TH AUGUST 2010. STAGING WILL BE ALLOWED UP TO 9.00PM ON THE EVENING BEFORE THE SHOW.
- 4.** TRAYS BOXES AND STANDS MUST BE SUPPLIED BY THE EXHIBITOR. VASES WILL BE AVAILABLE.
- 5.** ANTIRRHINUMS WILL BE JUDGED AS ANNUALS FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SHOW
- 6.** THE COMMITTEE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO WITHHOLD OR DIMINISH THE PRIZE OF ANY CLASS WHERE THE EXHIBITS ARE CONSIDERED BY THEM TO BE OF INTERIOR QUALITY.
- 7.** THE COMMITTEE'S DECISION IS FINAL ON ALL MATTERS
- 8.** THE SHOW GROUND IS PROTECTED BY A SECURITY GUARD WHO IS PRESENT OVER NIGHT. HOWEVER, THE COMMITTEE DOES NOT TAKE ANY RESPONSIBILITY FOR DAMAGE OR LOSS SUSTAINED TO EXHIBITS BEFORE DURING OR AFTER THE SHOW.
- 9.** ANY TROPHIES AWARDED TO SUCCESSFUL EXHIBITORS ARE THE PROPERTY OF THE SOCIETY AND SHOULD BE RETURNED NO LATER THAN 30TH JULY OF THE FOLLOWING YEAR
- 10.** ANY OBJECTION TO THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES MUST BE MADE IN WRITING AND DELIVERED TO THE SECRETARY BY NOON ON THE SHOW DAY ACCOMPANIED BY A £5 DEPOSIT WHICH WILL BE REFUNDED IF THE OBJECTION IS UPHELD
- 11.** THE EXHIBITORS TENT WILL BE CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC AT 4.30PM. AFTER THAT TIME THE EXHIBITORS MAY COLLECT THEIR EXHIBITS AND AWARDS. ANY EXHIBITS UNCLAIMED AFTER 5.00PM WILL BE SOLD AND THE PROCEEDS OF SALE APPLIED FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SOCIETY
- 12.** ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE GROWN BY THE EXHIBITORS EXCEPT THOSE IN FLORAL ART CLASSES AND CHILDRENS CLASSES
- 13.** NO APPLICATION WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM STALLHOLDERS SOLELY INTERESTED IN THE SALE OF GOODS
- 14.** CHEQUES FOR ENTRY FEES SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO "THE HALIFAX AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY LIMITED"

- ALL ENTRIES MUST BE ASSEMBLED “IN SITU” (EXCEPT CLASSES 72 AND 75)
- DRAPES MAY BE USED BUT SHOULD NOT EXCEED SPACE ALLOWED
- ARRANGEMENTS NOT TO EXCEED SPACE ALLOWED
- THE ARRANGEMENT MUST PREDOMINATE OVER ACCESSORIES, DRAPES ETC (A BASE IS NOT CLASSED AS AN ACCESSORY)
- NO ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS OR PLANTS MAY BE USED UNLESS STATED IN THE SCHEDULE

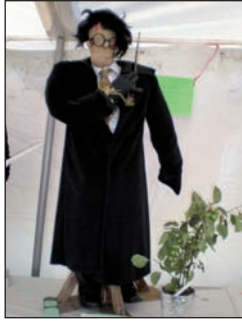
